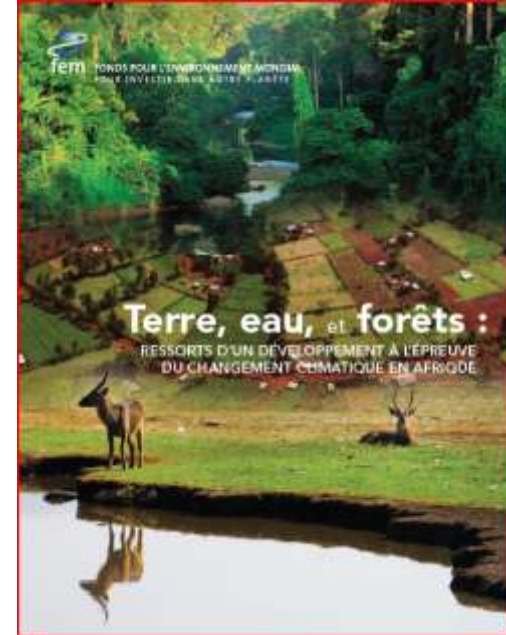

20 ans de projets forêts



- Depuis 1991, le FEM a financé plus 330 projets et programmes liés aux forêts
- Plus de \$1.6 milliard et \$7 milliards de cofinancement
- Mandat sous les trois conventions de Rio
- Objectif FEM5: un milliard de \$ sur la GDF/REDD+
- Un Programme incitatif sur la gestion durable des forêts et REDD+

La France dans le FEM



- La France: 5^{ème} pays donateur du FEM
- Pour FEM5 (2010-2014): € 215.5M (= \$ 280M)
- **Chaque \$ de la France génère 15 autres \$ du FEM** en don (pour une reconstitution à 4.25 milliards) et 60 dollars de cofinancement.
- **En ce qui concerne spécifiquement les forêts:**
 - ✓ **La France a investi \$100 million dans le programme GDF/REDD+.**
 - ✓ **Chaque \$ de la France va générer 10 autres dollars en dons supplémentaires et \$40 en cofinancement.**

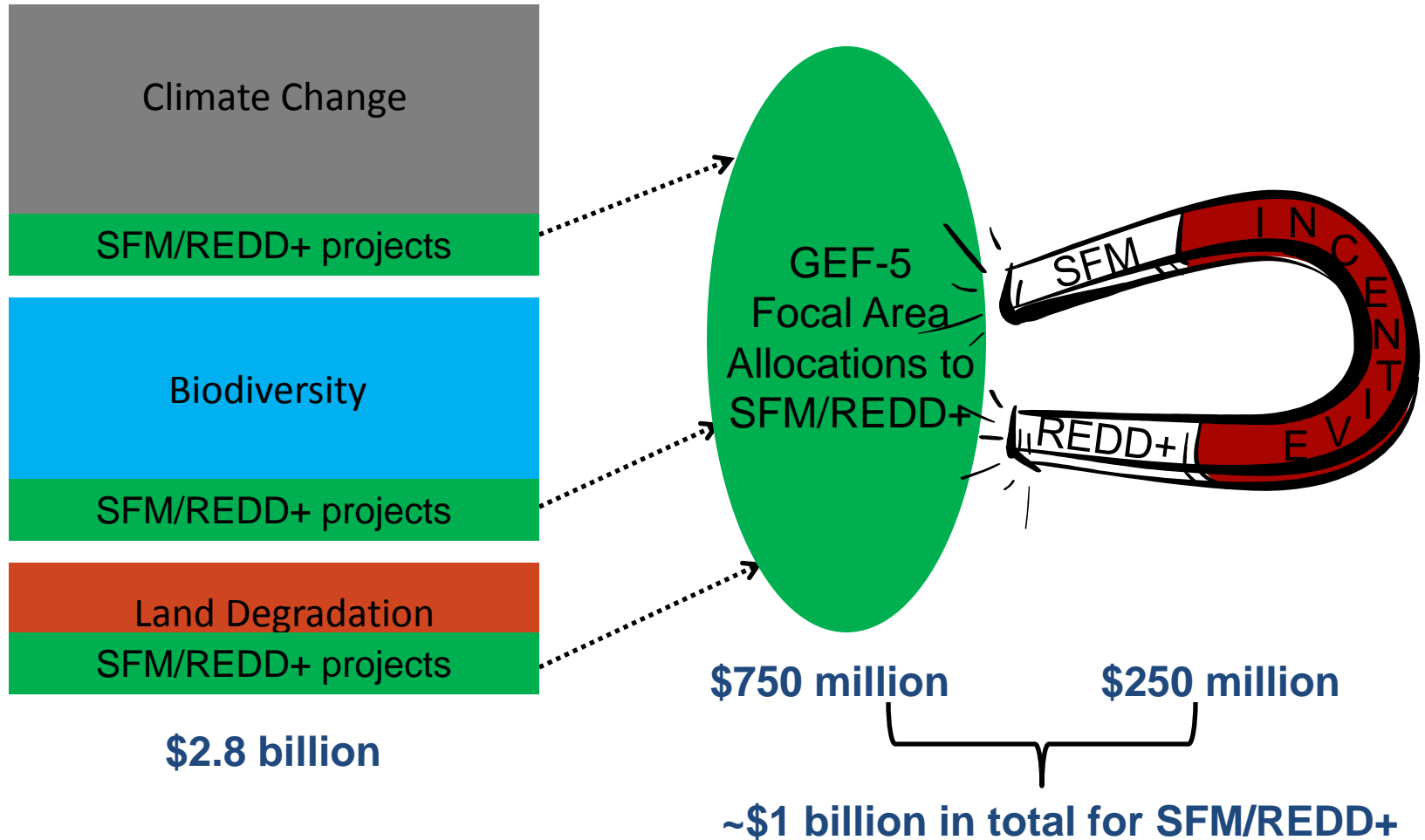
La Stratégie GDF/REDD+ dans FEM5

- **But**: Obtenir des bénéfices environnementaux multiples grâce à une gestion améliorée de tous les types de forêts
- **Impacts**: Sécuriser les services des écosystèmes forestiers et les moyens d'existence des populations dépendantes de l'utilisation des ressources des forêts
- Utiliser des ressources d'au moins deux domaines du FEM → pour optimiser les bénéfices multiples
- Pour chaque \$3, le programme GDF/REDD+ rajoute 1\$
- Pour des projets de # \$ 3 à 30 million

Objectifs de la Stratégie FEM5

1. Reduce pressure on forest resources and generate sustainable flows of forest ecosystem services

Projects may focus on: Forest policy, (re)- formulation, forest certification, community and small-holder forestry, Payments for Environmental Services, reduced-impact logging, integrated forest fire management

Objectifs de la Stratégie FEM5

2. Strengthen the enabling environment to reduce GHG emissions from REDD-plus

Projects may focus on: Competition for land use, building of technical and institutional capacities to monitor GHG emissions, testing approaches that allow for the generation of revenues from the carbon market

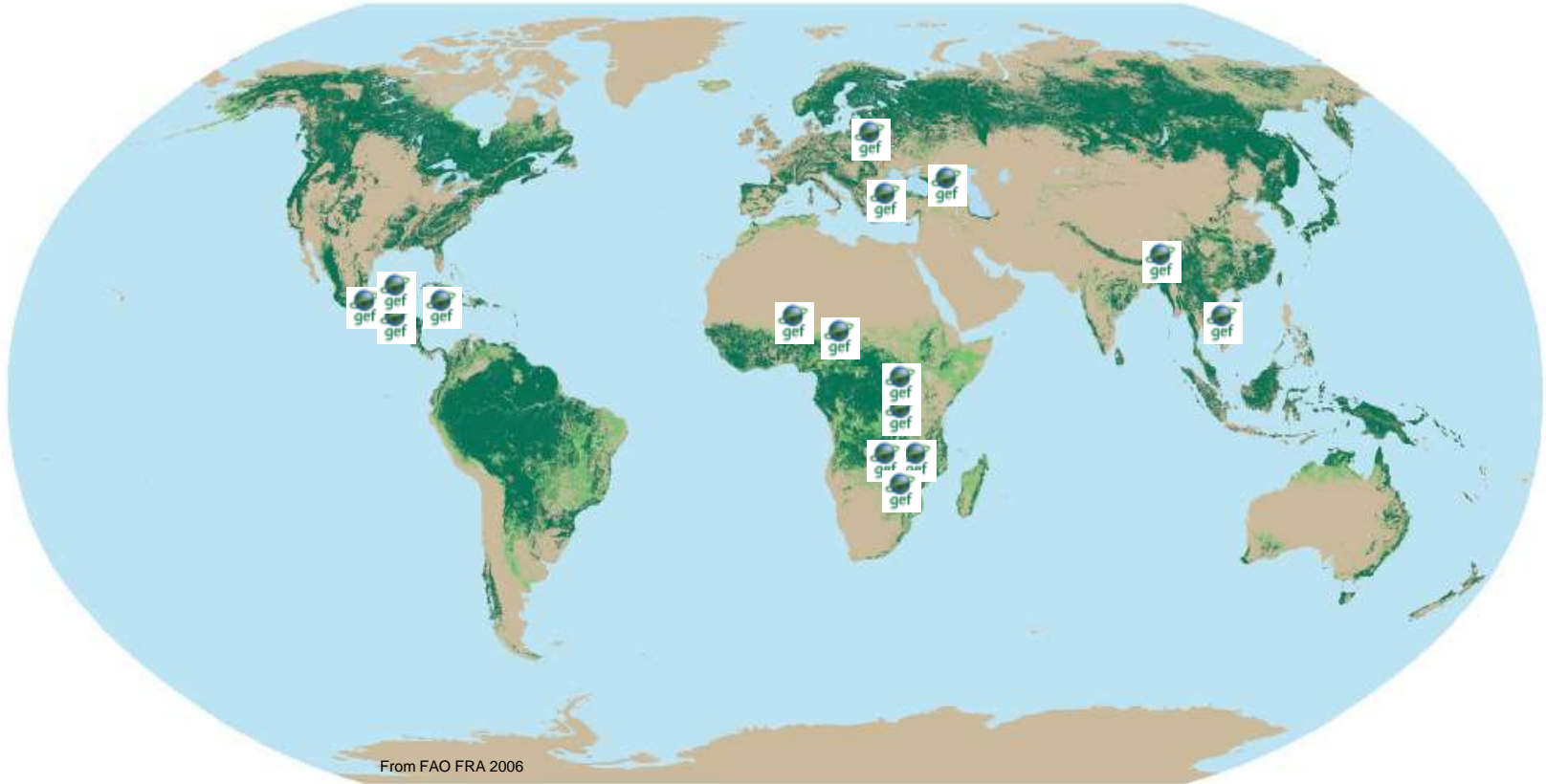


Mechanism for Voluntary Mitigation of Greenhouse Gas Emissions in Colombia

An innovative market-based project is about to start implementation in Colombia financed with a \$2,700,000 grant from the GEF. Executed by Fundación Natura, and with the Inter American Development Bank as GEF

implementing agency, "Mechanism for Voluntary Mitigation of Greenhouse Gas Emissions in Colombia", will establish the technological basis and institutional platform for a verified emission reductions (VERs) market mechanism, and support the promotion of forest carbon projects.
